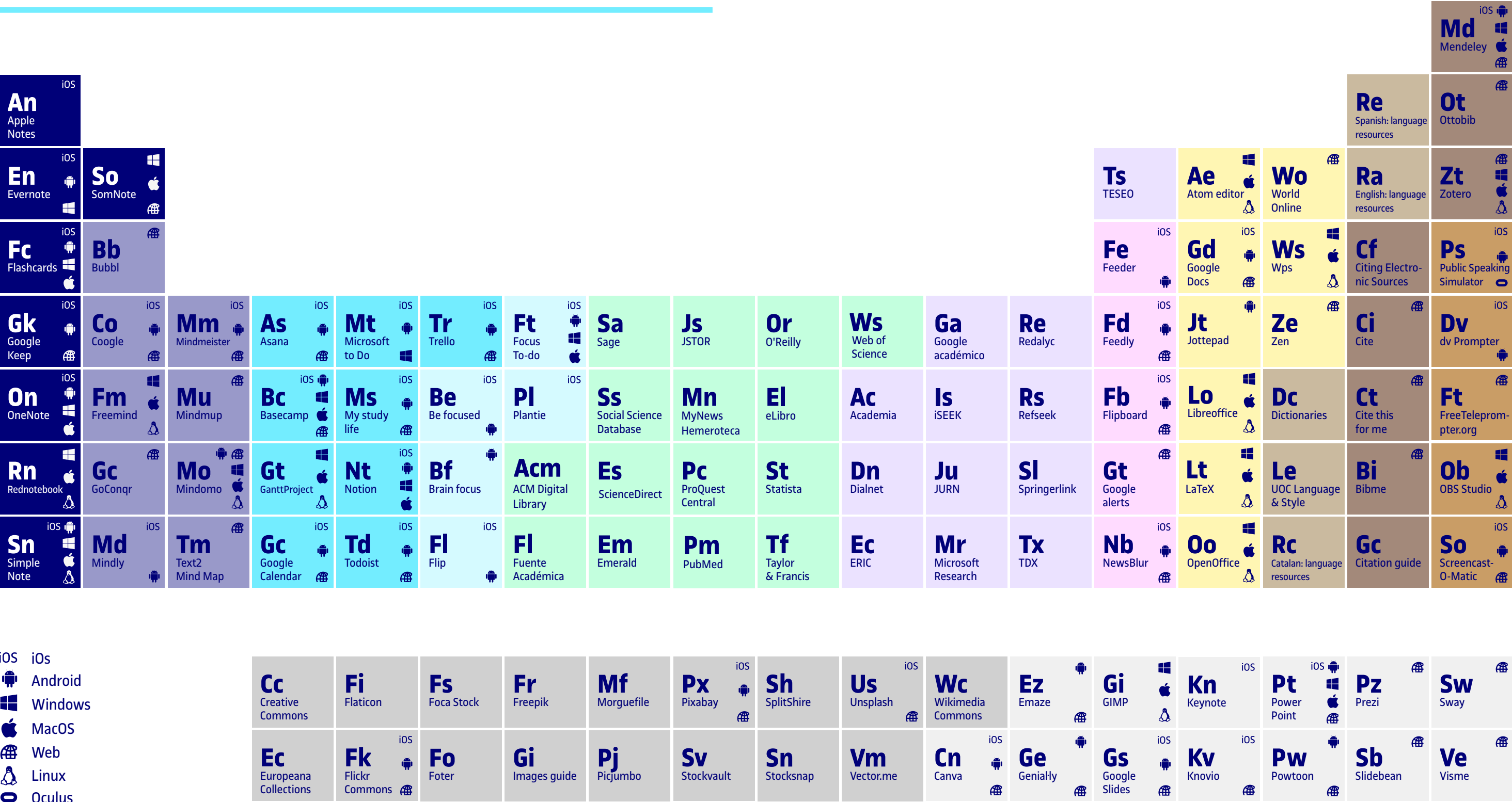


Tools for working on your final project

PREPARATION

- Note taking apps**
Apps that let you record and organize your thoughts online.
- Mental maps**
Get your ideas in order, link concepts and build visual representations.
- Planners**
Agendas, digital calendars and project management platforms.
- Concentrate**
Apps designed to increase your productivity and get rid of distractions.

SEARCHING FOR INFORMATION

- Platforms offered by the Library**
Specialist subscription content for different fields of study, made available to UOC students.
- Academic search tools**
Free search engines that enable you to locate reliable and authoritative information in one single search.
- Keeping up to date**
You can stay up to date on whatever topic interests you using RSS readers, alerts and news aggregators.

WRITE-UP

- Text editors**
There are various text processors which you can use for writing up your project and are freely available.
- Language resources**
Tools to help you resolve doubts about spelling, grammar and word choices.
- Cite other works correctly**
Bibliographic managers, automatic citation tools and guides showing you how to cite according to the ISO, APA or Vancouver criteria.

PRESENTATIONS AND DEFENCE

- Recording software**
Apps to practise and record your presentations, helping to conquer the fear of speaking to an audience.
- Picture archives**
Photos and illustrations that you can use in your projects, available under Creative Commons licences and in the public domain.
- Graphics tools**
Free software that you can use to make infographics, edit pictures and create attractive presentations.
